- c. Discussion and Possible Action on Open Gym Event Decision by acclamation to move forward with an event of some kind. Events Committee to research further and report back.
- d. Approval of Furnace Replacements in Building #1 and #4, along with Wiring of Building #2 Thermostats – Presentation by Administrator Jenkins recommending the lowest bidder of Kiernan & Laitinen. Trustee Rude stated desire for 3rd lowest bidder, Keystone, based on ongoing relationship with the Village. President Rossi stated desire to remain adherent to bid process and choose the lowest bidder – also cited less costly maintenance with Carrier unit provided by lowest bidder. Admin Jenkins reviewed Village Purchasing Policy to underline the bidding process and provide clarification of when bids other than the lowest may be accepted by the Boards discretion. Motion by Rude to Approve 3rd lowest bidder, Keystone, based on ongoing relationship and familiarity with the Village, for an amount not-to-exceed \$8,000.00 for the replacement of two furnaces (Building #1 and #4) along with the wiring of thermostats in Building #2 from the Taylor Complex Line Item. 2nd by Berrios. President Rossi called for a Roll Call vote.
