*Participate in an organized and active Neighborhood Block Watch*

### **A** - **Alert and Aware**

*Be mindful of who and what doesn't belong in your neighborhood*

### **S** - **Suspicious Activity**

*Report all suspicious activity to law enforcement - trust your instincts! Don't presume that someone else has already contacted police*

### **I** - **Informed**

*Like and follow the Racine Neighborhood Watch Facebook page for relevant safety posts and timely crime prevention tips*

### **C** - **Call and Report**

*Call 911 in an emergency; call Racine County Communications Center non-emergency dispatch, 262-886-2300, for all other incidents*
